C. Base Borden Rod and Gun Club Constitution

1. The Base Borden Rod & Gun Club (BBRGC) holds a number of annual hunting events. This is to assist in the population management and conservation efforts of the deer, turkey and small game populations as per Reference A.

2. As Commander CFB Borden, I have authorized the following hunting events in accordance with the safety standards in Reference B, and the prioritization of the use of the CFB Borden Range and Training Area (RTA) based on Reference C. The authorized hunting events take place within the CFB Borden RTA as follows:

- a. Small Game Hunting will be authorized from 23 September 2019 to 29 February 2020, with the exception of coyote, which is open all year long; and
- b. Deer Archery Hunting will be authorized from 30 September 2019 to 31 December 2019. The two exceptions will be during the two Controlled Deer Hunts, where Archery Deer Hunting is not authorized, as per dates list below in Para 3.
- 3. The following short hunting events are authorized:
 - a. The Spring Turkey Gun/Bow Hunting Event from 25 April to 31 May 2019;
 - b. The Fall Turkey Gun Hunting Event from 9 October to 21 October 2019;

- c. The November Controlled Deer Hunting Event from 4 November to 8 November 2019; and
- d. The December Controlled Deer Hunting Event from 2 December to 6 December 2019.
