BASE BORDEN ROD AND GUN CLUB – DATES FOR FY 22/23 HUNTING SEASONS AND EVENTS

- 1. The Base Borden Rod & Gun Club (BBRGC) holds a number of annual hunting events. This is to assist in the population management and conservation efforts of the deer, turkey and small game populations as per Reference A.

- 2. As Commander CFB Borden, I have authorized the following hunting events in accordance with the safety standards in Reference B, and the prioritization of the use of the CFB Borden Range and Training Area (RTA) based on Reference C. The authorized hunting events take place within the CFB Borden RTA as follows:
 - a. Small Game Hunting will be authorized from 25 September 2022 to 28 February 2022, with the exception of coyote, which is open all year long; and
 - b. Deer Archery Hunting will be authorized from 01 October 2022 to 31 December 2022. The two exceptions will be during the two Controlled Deer Hunts, where Archery Deer Hunting is not authorized, as per dates list below in Para 3.
- 3. The following short hunting events are authorized:
 - a. The Spring Turkey Hunting Event from 25 April to 31 May 2022;
 - b. The Fall Turkey Bow Hunting Event from 1 October to 31 October 2022:
 - c. With a concurrent Fall Turkey Shot Gun event from 11 October to 23 October 2022;
 - d. The November Controlled Deer Hunting Event from 7 November to 11 November 2022; and
 - e. The December Controlled Deer Hunting Event from 28 November to 2 December 2022.



- 4. Note that these activities remain subject to all restrictions and Public Health Measures imposed within the management of OP LASER and pandemic management in CFB Borden at the time of activities.
