Shooting Qualification for upcoming hunts are the weekends of April 09-10/23-24 2022

This is the time of year, when we get ready for the upcoming hunting seasons.

All shooting qualifications that took place last year have expired. Therefore, we are all required to qualify for 2022-23 hunting season.

Worry not for we have a plan 😊

We are currently booked for both hunter shooting qualifications and briefings as per normal or possibly a slight COVID modification(s) to achieve the aim of getting us out hunting, masks may still be required but hopefully this is no longer required on base for the shooting qualification dates. The archery qualifications will also run on these dates and the safety briefs will follow the range shoots at the indoor archery range. The firearms shoots will be on Langemark range so arrive NLT 08:00 hours to get your mandatory range safety brief. Please ensure that you are using the weapon(s) that you plan to use for the hunt. If you are not on a team for the hunt, please let your hunting directors know and they will ensure that you get on a team.

To avoid everyone waiting in line to confirm their info at the safety brief we need everyone to submit their info ASAP and NLT April 5 to your hunting directors and we will get the info into the club master list and get the appropriate names into Range Control.
